





Małgorzata Stankiewicz b. Olsztyn, Poland (1986) living and working in Switzerland

małgorzata stankiewicz is an artist, poet and a re-searcher, an older sister, a daughter, and an aunt of Baltic-Slavic descent. In her lifework practice, małgo is curiously drawn to ways of knowing that have been forgotten or erased, intentionally or otherwise, by the predominant Western culture of domination and rationalism. Weaving together performance, poetry, installation and sound, małgo's work circulates around the notions of ecology, community, storytelling, symbolism, ritual and meaningful chance, and is deeply informed by her interdisciplinary approach to research and commitment to bringing together hitherto separate threads of knowledge. To date, she has participated in exhibitions and cultural events throughout Europe, North America, and Asia. In 2017, she was awarded the Unseen Dummy Award for her artist's book *cry of an echo* dedicated to the unlawful destruction of the Białowieża Forest. Her upcoming publication *Swells* explores the phenomenon of aquatic hypoxia in the Baltic Sea and will be published in late 2023. She is also working on a collection of essays and poetry, *many out of one mouth*, due in 2024.
